PUBLIC NOTICE

In terms of provisions of Rule 64(2) of Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Rules, 1985 :

“The authority in charge of drugs control in a State (hereinafter referred to as the Licensing Authority) shall consult the Narcotics Commissioner with regard to the assessed annual requirements of each of the psychotropic substances in bulk form referred to in sub-rule (1) in the country and taking into account the requirement of such psychotropic substances in the State, the quantity of such substance required for supply to other manufacturers outside the State and the quantity of such substance required for reasonable inventory to be held by a manufacturer, shall specify, by order, the limit of the quantity of such substance which may be manufactured by the manufacturer in the State”.

2. Vide Public Notice of even number dated 15.12.2023 issued by this office, the State Drugs Controllers have been requested to submit the requirement for allocation of quota of Psychotropic Substance to Bulk Drug Manufacturers of Psychotropic Substances in order to facilitate manufacturing of Bulk Drug Psychotropic Substances right from the beginning of the next calendar year 2024, this office has decided to initially allocate **provisional quota equivalent to 25% of quota allocated during calendar year 2023 for each Psychotropic Substances for the next calendar year 2024.**

3. In response to above Public Notice, requirement of only three states namely Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana have been received for allocation of quota of psychotropic substances in the year 2024. Accordingly, the available quota, as approved by the INCB was distributed among the abovementioned three states.

4. The State FDA's other than Karnatka, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana are once again advised to furnish detailed requirement for allocation of psychotropic substances for the calendar year 2024 in the enclosed proforma **latest by 30th April, 2024.**

5. If no requirement for allocation of quota of Psychotropic Substances is received from States, NIL allocation of quota of Psychotropic Substances may be considered for their states for the Calendar year 2024 and any manufacturing of the bulk drug psychotropic substances within their state will now be considered as a violation of the Rule 64(2) of NDPS Rules, 1985.
